EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES

SKIN ABSORPTION: IN CASE OF CONTACT, IMMEDIATELY FLUSH EYES OR SKIN WITH PLENTY OF WATER FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES. INHALATION: REMOVE TO FRESH AIR.

SKIN CONTACT: IN CASE OF IRRITATION, FLUSH WITH WATER EYE CONTACT: IMMEDIATELY FLUSH EYES WITH PLENTY OF WATER FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES. EYELIDS SHOULD BE HELD APART DURING IRRIGATION TO INSURE WATER CONTACT WITH ENTIRE SURFACE OF EYES AND LIDS. CALL A PHYSICIAN.

CONTROL MEASURES
